- "One out of four births in the UK is to an immigrant woman (MMBRACE, 2019).
 - They bear the highest risk of dying: 3% for Asian women, and 5% for black women and 8% during Covid 19 pandemic(MBBRACE, 2019)...
- Black women's perinatal health outcome is seemingly linked to the following:
- inequality experience in accessing health service (Higginbottom et al, 2019)
- Ø Social cultural influence and negative experience of health service (Knight et al, 2017
